**Minutes of the meeting – 20 October 2025 at Dehesa School (Cafeteria/Auditorium) 4612 Dehesa Road, El Cajon CA 92029**

**A. ROLL CALL.** Vice Chair Tim Lucas called the meeting to order at 6:31 PM. Roll call was conducted. Planning Group members Griffin, Branch, Healy, Manning, Lutz-Partain, Morgan, Geiger, and Lucas were present, forming a quorum of 8. Members Nehring, Ulm, Becker were excused, Rich was absent. Seats 8, 13 and 14 are vacant.

**B. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE (optional).** The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

**C. APPROVAL OF MINUTES** – Motion made by Member Branch to approve September 8, 2025 minutes. Motion passed (8 yes, 0 no, 0 abstain)

**D. PUBLIC COMMUNICATION**

An opportunity for members of the public and Planning Group to speak on items within the jurisdiction of the Planning Group and not on the agenda. Time limit 3 minutes. No group discussion, action, or vote. Presentation by Andy Garcia from Sup Joel Anderson's office presented updates and a pamphlet on the 2024 Legislative Actions and Accomplishments, including info on the Holiday Legislative Open House on Monday – 12/1 from 6-8 @ Lakeside Rodeo – 12584 Maplevue St, Lakeside, the Neighborhood Reinvestment and Community Enhancement Grant Programs and accepting applications for internships. Sup Anderson was successful with his efforts to obtain \$19M to offset costs for the special election from the State.

Presentation by Ashkon Jones from Assemblymember Sharp-Collins office presented updates on the legislative packages – 6 of the 24 have been signed into law by Gov Newsom, including Assembly Bill 829 - To enhance the safety and accessibility of public schools, Assembly Bill 847 - Peace officers: confidentiality of records, Assembly Bill 927 - County superintendent of schools: inspection of public schools. Assemblymember Sharp-Collins office will be hosting an Apprentice Fair on 20 Nov at San Diego Continuing College of Education in City Heights, including 30 vendors providing information on job/apprenticeship opportunities to High School and College students.

Presentation by Kyle Hermann from Senator Brian Jones presented information on Senate Bill SB525 - To address housing affordability and homelessness in California to enhance housing development and support services, including manufactured homes to have access to the California Fair Plan insurance. Senate Bill SB586 - creating the state's first clear legal framework for registering electric motorcycles (eMotos) as off-highway vehicles (OHVs). The measure will allow eMoto riders to register their vehicles and access authorized OHV areas legally and safely. Senate Bill SB380 - paving the way to create a transitional housing program on state properties for Sexually Violent Predators vice into residential neighborhoods. Senate Bill SB79 - overrides local zoning limitations to allow greater heights and densities for residential development near transit stops. Also, legislators are out for the year starting 9/12/25 and Gov Newsom has until 10/13/25 to approve/veto any bills, then back in session on 1/5/26.

**F. GROUP BUSINESS - *Reports, updates, announcements, administrative discussions***

1. Announcements, including upcoming events, and Correspondence Received. None.
2. Discussion
  - a. Briefing on Dehesa Trail, County Department of Park and Recreation (DPR) – Presentation by Emmet Aquino (DPR) updated SPG on the Sycuan Trail Project Phase/Segment 1 (trail within tribal property – Dehesa Road) and Phase/Segment 2 (segments that fall north and south Sloane Canyon Road). Sycuan has an ongoing construction project for a utility corridor with plans for a recreation facility. There was a plan to work collaboratively with Sycuan and DPR but it resulted in lots of changes, so that lead to DPR deciding best use of efforts was to wait until Sycuan was completed and DPR will wait for Sycuan to complete their project and where DPR can reintroduce their project. In the meantime, DPR looked at working on Phase/Segment 2, but there were limitations

of staging areas, so that project is being paused so it doesn't impact the Sycuan project (no estimated completion date at this time). Member Becker asked when was the last time County/DPR met with the tribe, Mr. Aquino met with them approx. 3 months ago, but that was to discuss flood control. Member Becker expressed her concern regarding safe waterways. Member Manning asked what was the budget and that we couldn't start Phase I because of the staging area. Mr. Aquino responded that was correct because of the Sycuan staging area and taking longer than expected. In 2012 when the option agreement was executed in which the tribes entered into to allow the County to work with them, then 2020 received board authority to work together and comprised of 6 segments and segments 1 and 2 were funded at that time for \$3.5M and about 25% has been expended for the design of Phases 1 and 2. Phase 3 was within the CIP was budgeted with a quarterly adjustment and \$750K was slotted to start the project for a total of \$4.25M. Member Manning asked how many people were working on this administrative-wise – Mr. Aquino said it was only himself. Member Branch asked what is the cost inflationary impact since it was allocated in 2020 with an inflation rate of 5-8%/annum compounded, how much is left for the project and what is the current costs of the 2 phases. Mr. Aquino was not able to provide an answer – but did say DPR had several projects that are underbudgeted and challenged to complete. After Sycuan is completed with their project DPR will reassess and hopefully be able to complete the 2-3 phases as their goal. Member Branch commented that there should be some mitigation on behalf of the tribe due to the delays and suggested that community members and SPG members to support the County at the next status/progress meeting with Sycuan. VC Lucas asked about the less than ideal trail routing (so close to Dehesa Road) if that has been resolved. Mr. Aquino said that will be revisited when DPR starts meeting with Sycuan prior to start of project. Member Branch commented about the safety of Dehesa school crossing – possibly change the focus of the “trails” project and address it under “safe student pathways” (sidewalk trails) to increase visibility and funding opportunities. Community Trails Master Plan (CTMP) from 2009 is the latest approved plan to make regional connections. Member Geiger saw that there was a plan that went through his property and was told to reach out to Mr. Aquino to discuss more with the trails coordinator. Member Branch recommended a 6 month update.

Briefing on Park Land Dedication Ordinance (PLDO) – Presentation by Mark Caro (DPR) discussed what PLDO that requires new residential developments to pay fees to create parks and DPR requests communities to set priorities for what they want. Request was sent to SPG in September for our priorities and then will be incorporated with other community groups (approx. 24) for the Capital Improvement Needs Assessment. All inputs will be reviewed/prioritized and funded based on current resources. Member Manning asked about status of South Lane Park upgrades (SPG number 1 priority). Carl McCullough (DPR) responded that the concept design is complete which used the majority of the funding available and DPR is now looking for other funding to complete the project. Mr. McCullough will send up the concept design for South Lane Park. Member Griffin asked why the swinging gates are locks and Mr. McCullough replied because kids were riding dirt bikes and ripping up the property. Member Branch asked how the DPR priority list is performed and Mr. Caro replied it was upper management. Mr. Carol recommended to submit any requirements and advocacy letters to improve their position in the ranking and if not PLDO, DPR might be able to fund from other sources. Member Branch asked for the list of the other 24 community groups to increase collaboration.

Member Morgan had to leave the meeting due to family issue, therefore, SPG fell below quorum required at 7:50 to continue official meeting, but VC Lucas suggested that the brief on the ADU rules could be an informal informational presentation.

- b. Briefing on ADU rules and regulations, County Department Planning and Development Services – Enrique Flores briefed County PDS, mentioned there will be a webinar on 10/22/25 and solicit public feedback. Mr. Flores briefed on the Draft ADU Ordinance Amendment project with 2 components – 1) amending the County's Zoning Ordinance to reorganize and clarify the ADU and

Junior ADU (JADU) section for alignment with State law and improved public guidance; 2) the development of a local program under AB1033 to allow for the separate sale of ADUs in certain cases – creating new homeownership opportunities. After received input, PDS will go to the board for final review/approval (or not) in early 2026. Member Manning asked for clarification on AB1033 and Mr. Flores said it will be addressed in the brief. County is following State baseline law – residents can build 2 ADUs on their property – one must be detached and the other must be attached and then you can have a JADU (inside the house) along with the resident’s home. City of San Diego has a density bonus ADU program which allows more, but the County is not pursuing that. The exception to the 4 units/parcel is SB9 (which is more restrictive) where you can administratively split your lot (so not officially split with 2 separate parcel numbers) and then each new lot can have a maximum of 2 units. Member Branch asked the sq footage requirements for ADU – Mr. Flores responded – 1200 sqft, JADU – 500 sqft. Amber Jagers briefed on AB1033 – “why are we considering this” - to facilitate pathways to people that want homeownership, seniors to downsize and stay in the neighborhood and as a tool for homeowners if they choose to this option. If ADU condos are created, then a subsequent homeowners association will be required and then each unit will have their own property tax bill and comply with the subdivision map act. Residents with septic can be a pinch point and may require updates to increase capacity. Member Branch asked for clarification on why the City can build more on a parcel than County. Mr. Flores replied the City is using the Density Bonus Program if they provide affordable units. Member Becker asked how tall can they make the ADU, Mr. Flores responded – 2 stories but must still meet the local zoning requirements. VC Lucas made the comment that SB9 mostly applies to rural areas and AB1033 would be for Granite Hills urban area. Stakeholders feedback were parking impacts, increased density in High Fire Zones. Ms. Jagers asked for input from SPG. Member Manning observed vice ADUs, Harbison Canyon is building houses. Member Branch commented on access in case of emergency on single lane roads, since residents are “developing” but no funds to deal with the impact of the increased population. Tim Scherer asked if there was a limit on the increase of cars when ADUs are built – Mr. Flores said there was no limit, but under condo conversion process, the State Fire Code would require the road be re-evaluated for the dead-end length and turnaround requirements so some roads may not qualify for additional units. VC Lucas requested PDS comes back at a later SPG mtg when we have a quorum.

**REQUEST FOR FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2025-26 PARK LAND DEDICATION ORDINANCE (PLDO)  
AND RECREATION PROGRAMMING PRIORITY LISTS**

Dear Ron Nehring:

The mission of the County of San Diego Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) is to enhance the quality of life in San Diego County by providing exceptional parks and recreation experiences and preserving significant natural resources. DPR facilities build strong and sustainable communities by providing residents with space to exercise, recreate and gather, which supports their physical, social, emotional and mental well-being. DPR's award-winning park system features 159 facilities across 58,000 acres of land, including parks, campgrounds, sports parks, community and teen centers, splash pads, fishing lakes, open space preserves, historic sites and over 393 miles of trails.

In an effort to meet the need of a growing and changing San Diego population, the County maintains a Parks Master Plan (PMP) and identifies important projects for that Plan, in part, through Park Land Dedication Ordinance (PLDO) Priority Letters.

DPR is seeking your community's input on the PLDO and Recreation Programming priorities for the Crest-Dehesa Local Park Planning Area (LPPA).

**PLDO PROJECT PRIORITY LIST**

DPR requests that the Crest /Dehesa/Granite Hills/Harbison Canyon Community Planning Group (CPG) recommend projects eligible for PLDO funding for the FY2025-26 PLDO Priority Project List



for the Crest-Dehesa LPPA. The most recent PLDO Priority Project List information received from your group is attached.

Pursuant to Board Policy F-26: Utilization of Park Lands Dedication Ordinance Fees and Interest, DPR annually requests a 5-year priority list from each Community Planning and Sponsor Group to identify community recommendations for use of PLDO funds.

Upon receiving your Group's recommended PLDO priority list, DPR will analyze the priority list for conformance with the PLDO and Board Policy F-26. This information will also be considered in the Park Master Plan (PMP) which is the framework for the long-term use and development of DPR Facilities. The plan allows us to assess existing and future recreational needs, align investment with community necessities, evaluate feasible options and develop a strategic plan to request funding and to budget for long-term or phased development improvements.

If a project is eligible to receive PLDO funding, it can be included in the County's Capital Improvements Needs Assessment (CINA) process pursuant to Board Policy F-26: Utilization of Park Lands Dedication Ordinance Fees and Interest. The CINA is a planning document that includes a comprehensive list of all planned capital projects over a five-year period that require the appropriation of funding for community outreach, planning, design, environmental analysis, and construction.

If considered, DPR staff will coordinate with your group to determine a project's feasibility and summarize the process for completing the project. Please note that DPR will consider projects on the recommended priority list, as well as general community recreational needs when determining whether to bring recommendations forward to the Board of Supervisors for consideration. In some instances, DPR may recommend park improvements that are needed but not on a community's priority list.

### **RECREATION PROGRAMMING PRIORITY LIST**

The Recreation Programming Plan defines DPR's major recreation program goals for the next 5 years. The purpose of the Recreation Programming Plan is to improve services by providing recreational programming that meets the unique needs of each community.

Examples of recreational programs include youth sports, teen programs, dance and cooking classes, senior exercise programs, cultural arts and special events. Recreational programming cannot be funded using fees collected pursuant to the PLDO.

DPR requests that the Crest /Dehesa/Granite Hills/Harbison Canyon CPG recommend recreational programs for the Crest-Dehesa LPPA. Program recommendations will be evaluated, and if they are approved these programs will be included in the next Recreation Programming Plan for parks in your community.

Please submit your Group's PLDO and recreational programming priorities using the attached priority form to DPR no later than January 1, 2026. If there are no changes proposed to last year's priority lists, please indicate so on the form and return to DPR.
