Discuss the Voters Choice Act (ACT) and the upcoming public consultation meetings that are required before the County's new election administration plan is implemented in June 2022.** Under this plan, every active registered voter in San Diego County will automatically receive a ballot in the mail nearly a month before Election Day. Ballots can then be returned by mail, or at a secure Ballot Drop Off Location, or at a Vote Center near you. Why the change? The County of San Diego Board of Supervisors directed the Registrar of Voters to transition to the Voter's Choice Act model on October 19, 2021.
