The oversight/management of the \$3.55 million in undesignated JVR community benefit funds appears to be a separate issue. **Discuss/vote on requesting that County PDS deposit the undesignated funds in a unique interest-bearing account perhaps with the San Diego Foundation until an appropriate management structure has been agreed on by the County and Jacumba residents.**
