Subject: Transportation Funds for Rural Highway Safety

Dear Representative Issa:

The Jamul-Dulzura Community Planning Group (JDCPG) represents the unincorporated communities of Jamul and Dulzura in areas of planning; including roadways and highways and as an advisor to the County Board of Supervisors in all land use matters. Safety on our roads is of the utmost importance to our communities and is demonstrated through the work of our JDCPG subcommittee on Public Safety, Emergency Evacuation, Traffic and Crime.

Additionally, the unincorporated communities of Jamul and Dulzura continuously face a tremendous wildfire threat similar to the one that Los Angeles has always and is unfortunately experiencing today. To address this threat, the JDCPG recently coordinated/participated in a tour with SANDAG, Caltrans, CAL FIRE and the San Diego Sheriff Department of our main highway thoroughfare SR-94 and other main Jamul-Dulzura evacuation routes in the event of a wildfire or other emergency. This group was able to experience, first-hand, the community's evacuation routes as well as accurately evaluate these routes for safety improvements and viability. It was clear that a number of viable safety improvements are seriously needed. The JDCPG, as well as the communities of Jamul and Dulzura, also looks forward to your support in addressing our needs and improving safety on our roadways.

Moving forward, the JDCPG strongly supports the current efforts to hold a meeting between SANDAG, unincorporated area leadership (The Association of Planning Groups which represents approximately 500K of your constituents) and you with the end goal of bringing federal funds to improve safety and emergency wildfire evacuation on our main highway thoroughfare SR 94.
