1. Call to Order at 7:00 pm

2. Roll Call: Quorum established with 10 of 15 members present.

3. Approval of Minutes:

January 21, 2025, and February 4, 2025 - Tabled until March 4, 2025

4. Open Forum

Discussed the *Steele Canyon Sand Mines* and the *Dark Skies* ordinance for rural East County associated with *Jamul Casino and Entertainment Center*.

5. Letterhead Format for Jamul-Dulzura Community Planning Group

Pending awaiting further response from the Community.

6. Wildfire Evacuation Tour with San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) and CALTRANS (California Department of Transportation) in Jamul and Dulzura along State Route 94.

Vice Chair, Paul Dombkowski - The SANDAG group is looking into the timing of the traffic lights. He will continue to follow up with CALTRANS.

Members of the JDCPG remarked about the traffic on State Route 94 West, making the morning commute an hour to exit Jamul. The traffic light timer is not calibrated, causing 15-minute delays at all hours of the day and night.

The Jamul Casino and Entertainment Center construction has increased the number and severity of traffic incidents at Maxwell Street entering State Route 94. A member of the JDCPG will speak with California Highway Patrol Captain Vargas regarding signage or a flashing light to slow drivers.

The Chair Lisa Hodgson plans to contact Chief Executive Officer of SANDAG, Mario Orso to schedule a meeting to discuss the issue with Congressman Darrell Issa's office to address wildfire evacuation and fire mitigation in Jamul.

7. Association of Planning Groups (APG)

APG Chair Chief Executive Officer of SANDAG, Mario ORSO sent a letter to Congressman Darrell Issa and spoke with a staff member at Congressman Darrell Issa's San Diego office. The APG Chair is requesting a meeting with Congressman Darrell Issa's office, SANDAG (Mario Orso), regarding wildfire evacuation routes and emergency evacuation strategies for Old Campo Road/State Route 94 and the neighboring areas.

On *Friday, February 21, 2025*, the **APG** is meeting with the **SANDAG** policy advisory committee. The **Vice Chair, Paul Dombkowski** has been appointed a **SANDAG** advisory committee member.

8. Draft a Letter to Congressman Darrell Issa to request a meeting.

9. Jamul Casino Hotel and Entertainment Center Expansion Project Member Darla Kasmedo updated the JDCPG regarding the *Dark Skies*complaint status.

The *Jamul Casino* has added a flashing light on top of the casino. There is a bright red light on the *Jamul Casino* sign. **Member Darla Kasmedo** has drafted a letter on behalf of her neighborhood regarding the light pollution issue. The letter references the **TEIR**. Asking for an assessment of the light pollution. **GUEST Rodney** - Bright lights are distracting coming around the corner. The bright lights are impacting the *Dark Skies* native to the area. Impact to property value.

Member Ed Mollon added that the adverse impacts of light pollution make it difficult to sleep.

Suggested a survey of neighboring private properties and businesses to assess the adverse effect of the **Jamul Casino/Entertainment Center** light pollution. The **JDCPG Chair Lisa Hodgson**, stated the *Jamul Casino's* violation of *Dark Skies* policies. The community has the right to file a complaint.

Member Preston Brown will discuss the environmental impacts with the *Sierra Club*. The Light attracts birds and has a detrimental effect on native plants and animals.

Chair Lisa Hodgson recommended each organization or individual file separate complaints.

With follow-on letters from the *Sierra Club*.

Member Darla Kasmedo noted the *Jamul Casino* had a Super Bowl commercial featuring the Rooftop pool.

10. Jamul Shopper

Member Eve Nasby thanked other members who agreed to be interviewed and have their bios published.

11. Community Grant Program (PLDO)

The **JDCPG** surveyed the community regarding the placement of a park in Jamul. Of the 119 responses to the survey, the majority wanted a playground with walking trails. Twenty individuals commented that a park would attract homeless people.

Discussion of a baseball park at **Oak Grove**. The members commented regarding the need for tree trimming and a plot map to visualize the baseball field and park at Oak Grove.

The members believe a BBQ area would be formidable due to wildfire risk. **Dan Neirinckx**, the lead, commented that the *Barrett house* was considered in the past. The **JDCPG** needs the input of residents and an engineer to develop a design blueprint with the cost. The engineering blueprint with costs will be requested in a proposal for the <u>March 18th</u> **JDCPG** meeting. The **JDCPG** is also looking for the support of the *Jamul-Dulzura Unified School District*.

12. Capital Improvement Project

The *Department of Public Works* is requesting input on prioritizing capital improvement and maintenance projects for county-maintained assets -

Project Request Form due March 30, 2025.

Addition of projects

Member Darla Kasmedo sent an email with a list of the projects. Combine all projects into one chart to prioritize projects. Confirm *the priority of requested projects*.

Rodney (guest) requested the location online of the list of Capital Improvement Projects for **Jamul-Dulzura**.

The **Chair Lisa Hodgson** offered the projects a few cycles to be listed on the County webpage as *Capital Improvement Projects -CIP*.

Member Nasby stated the County has a web page titled: "Tell Us Now." This is a San Diego County application to disclose problems such as road repair, tree trimming, brush abatement, and fire abatement. Chair Lisa Hodgson stated that the school district and the *California Highway Patrol* had moved the bus stop because there were line-of-sight issues with the speed limit. A Petition from Joel Anderson for a speed zone in the residential area would be preferred. These are not Capital Improvement Projects. Member Darla Kasmedo is compiling and revising a list of projects on the Capital Improvement list to be voted on at the next meeting on March 4, 2025.
