1. Call to Order: 7:00 pm
2. Roll Call

3. Review and Approval of Minutes: April 7, 2026
 - **Michael Casinelli** moves to approve the April 7, 2026 Minutes as written.
 - **Motion passed unanimously.**
4. Open Forum
 - No Public Input this evening
5. SR-94: Meeting with CHP and SANDAG Comprehensive Multimodal Corridor Plan (CMCP)
 - **Preston Brown** shared the slide presentation from CMCP at their meeting back in March. The slides were also shared by email with JDCPG members.
 - JDCPG members discussed some of the deficiencies of the plan, including how the plan does not include the southern reach of SR 94 from Jamul to the Mexican border. This section is a vital link with increasingly heavy and diverse traffic crossing the border from Tecate. This cannot be ignored in this plan.
 - Various JDCPG members were not in favor of any bike lanes that may be added to SR 94, as this would limit any future lane expansions along the rural areas of SR 94.
 - **Lisa Hodgson** brought up the Wildfire Evacuation Tour and wondered if the organizers of the CMCP had been on the tour.
 - Members also were surprised that JDCPG had no representation on the CMCP group, and that JDCPG was not listed as one of the consulting Community Planning Groups. **Preston** has volunteered to reach out to Paula Zamudio and Ruby Morales about including a representative from JDCPG in future meetings.

- **Preston** and Darla Kasmedo will continue to coordinate with CHP Captain Monteagudo and Caltrans representative Tyler Hicks with respect to safety issues and dangerous speeding along SR 94.
- **Preston** said that Tyler Hicks has filed a full investigation form for the Maxwell/SR94 intersection to evaluate the need for signage and warning signals. Caltrans had said that signs were scheduled to be installed, but nothing has changed yet.

7. JIV Barrett Travel Center

- **Lucille Hargraves** asked about the status of the meeting with Andrew Hayes, Chairwoman Pinto, and several members of JDCPG. **Janet Mulder** will contact Andrew Hayes for an update on this.

- No other updates on the construction of Barrett Travel Center.
