**3. APPROVAL OF AGENDA for November 11, 2014 and minutes of October 28, 2014 regular meeting as corrected. Motion carried unanimously.**

**4. OPEN FORUM: Opportunity for public comment on any item not on the agenda – 3 minute time limit**

**a. Janet delivered an invitation from Nadine Bennett, Superintendent, Jamul Dulzura School District to the JDCPG members and the audience for the Ground Breaking for the Oak Grove Field taking place this Friday, Nov. 14 at 8:00 a.m.**

**b. Dan Neirinckx announced we would have a new member Eileen Poole. Dan will contact her and give her the training requirements in order to be seated. We also say “goodbye” to Richard Marzec, with regrets, but would encourage him to run for any future openings.**

**c. George Novinger will be absent for the December meeting.**

**d. Randy White brought up the pipes for the Daley Ranch that the community seems to feel is for the casino when the facts are the Daley Ranch is replacing the pipes that lead to the well on the old Daley property (now owned by CA Fish and Wildlife) and are privately owned and will feed the Fish & Wildlife reservoir. Judy Bohlen reminded us that Ca Fish and Wildlife earlier this year reported that they would be doing this. Janet said she had contacted Don Parent of SDG&E as a resident said the men painting the marks on SR94 said it was for an electric line. However an email from Don Parent that said SDG&E had no one authorized to mark the highway for them, but were interested to see who it was to make sure they were leaving room for the SDG&E lines to be put down later.**

**5. COUNTY ROAD REPAIR LIST UP-DATE – Dan Neirinckx**

**Dan** received an email from Peter Milligan, County Public Works, with some questions and he will send our answers.... Location of four corners? – Dan will show him! Specific repair needs? We suggested that all of Lyons Valley Road from Lyons Creek Road to “4 corners” intersection of Honey Springs, Lyons Valley Rd and Skyline Truck Trail. It is breaking up and in general disrepair. Failing patch on Hillside Drive location – Where road curves to the right after the house; it has a huge dip which is caused by a failing culvert. Olive Vista Drive at Kimberly off of Jamul Highlands does not connect – needs to be rectified. Skyline Truck Trail “large dip” is located between the two turns of Lawson Valley Road in the staggered intersection. The whole Lawson Valley Road from Skyline Truck Trail to Rudnick are the limits of the paved portion of Lawson Valley Road that has problems with the notable exception of the new bridge. Dan will notify Peter Milligan explaining these comments.
