B. Potrero County Park/Mason preserve to Harris Ranch Rd. trail update (Barger)

Emailed County Park Ranger Dani Cardiff – no updates

Was told that county park trail people were up in Campo inspecting trails – asked if they were coming to Potrero – they do yearly inspection

Mason Preserve – not official trail, but is considered a fire access road/break (northeast end of Mason Preserve there is a County owned firebreak easement that connects to Harris Ranch Rd.

D. Various Code violation updates (Meyer)

Brandon has an order for a property on Hartley Hill – follow-up on June 25

Highway 94 – semi-rig on property – trying to get a hold of them (property next to Cal Fire)

Was on the planning group briefly (5 years ago) – want to be more a part of the community and know how things work.

- B.** Notice of Funding Availability of 9 million for High-Speed Internet and affordability for projects in the unincorporated communities. There was a meeting in Campo on May 30 which County representatives discussed this project. (See handout)

Daniel went to meeting – started in 2021/2022 and involves several entities (County, Broadband vendor, et al., carrier/installer).

Window for public comment – window ended in 10 days and that was too limited a timeframe – reps from County and consulting firms – fielded questions and concerns

\$9 mil is for SDCty unincorporated areas – not sure who gets what piece of the pie

More money might come in but that is not known

A lot of their answers were vague and ambiguous. Didn't have a lot of details – kept saying it was still a new project

- C.** Campo/Lake Moreno Planning Group is asking support letters from different Planning Groups on the planned Crestwood cemetery in their area. Concerns are groundwater, traffic, noise, fire, etc. no regulations on cemeteries in the back country
Concerns extend to the fact that it's going to be a Muslim cemetery

Made a motion to send letter to Campo/Lake Morena Planning Group requesting more information (i.e. how many acres, how many burial plots, will there be a mausoleum)
