- I. Open Provisions
  - A. The meeting was called to order by Chair Paul Georgantas at 6:30 PM
  - B. Pledge of Allegiance
  - C. Attendance: Paul Georgantas, Lynne Malinowski, Frederick Rasp, Martin Kurland, Jon Gorr, Mark DiVecchio, and Greg Doud. 7 members being present, a quorum is declared.
- II. Motion to approve the agenda by Mr. Rasp, second Dr. Kurland, approved unanimously.
- III. Public Comments
  - A. None.
- IV. Consolidated Motion
  - A. Motion to approve prior meeting minutes from 18 May 2022 made by Mr. Doud, second Mr. Rasp, approved unanimously.
- V. Continued Items, Discretionary Projects and County Action Items

- VI. Old Business and Reports
  - A. Announcements and Correspondence Received – Chair Georgantas reported that he has forwarded email correspondence from the County.
  - B. Architectural Subcommittee – Ms. Malinowski reported that there is no update on date of Community Identification Sign program presentation to Board of Supervisors.
  - C. Social Media Subcommittee – Ms. Malinowski reported that she continues to post agenda and minutes to Rainbow Cares.

  - E. I-15 Corridor Design Review Board – Mr. Doud reported that there was minimal activity; 2 projects considered with no concerns.
  - F. Roads and traffic status – Dr. Kurland reported the traffic light project should be completed by fall. He put in request to planner for potential specific rush hour denoted sign “No Turn On Red”, but has not received a response. Mr. DeVecchio asked for follow up on the status of the replacement of the “Arizona Crossing” on 5<sup>th</sup> St with a bridge which was approved several years ago.

  - I. Cannabis and Social Equity Program update – Mr. Doud reported on the 14 Jun 2022 Board of Supervisors meeting regarding the Cannabis Taxation program. Final reading will occur at 28 Jun 2022 BoS meeting. Discussion on appropriate 75-word text to be printed on November ballot (which

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if passed would only require a simple majority), disconnect between taxes collected from unincorporated County regions but being distributed by General Fund for entire County, issues about Storefront Business Tax not being included in current ordinance.
