I. Open Provisions

- A. The meeting was called to order by Chair Kurland at 6:30 PM.
- B. Pledge of Allegiance
- C. Attendance: Present: Marty Kurland, Greg Doud, Lynne Malinowski, Jon Gorr, Ron Ehrlar, Pat Eastman, Michele Dahl, Paul Georgantas, Francesca Harris. Excused: Frederick Rasp. 9 members being present, a quorum is declared.

II. Motion to approve the prior meeting minutes from 21 January 2026 by Mr. Doud, second Ms. Dahl, approved unanimously

VI. Old Business and Reports

- A. Announcements and Correspondence Received – Chair Kurland reported that Bill Crocker, former board member, passed away recently.
- B. Architectural Subcommittee – Ms. Malinowski will work with Ms. Dahl.
- C. Social Media and Membership Subcommittee – Ms. Malinowski reported that the vacant seat #5 has been filled and there haven't been many County initiatives to post.
- D. Parks and Beautification Subcommittee – Ms. Dahl. Nothing New.
- E. I-15 Corridor Design Review Board – Mr. Doud reported that there were 4 minor projects at the past meeting with none affecting Rainbow.
- F. Roads and traffic status – Chair Kurland reported that the speed limit reduction on Rainbow Heights Rd was approved for the second reading at the 1/28/26 Board of Supervisors. Ms. Malinowski will follow up with DPW to determine the implementation schedule.
- G. Water and Environmental Issues Report – Chair Kurland. Nothing new.
- H. Community News and Grange – Ms. Dahl reported that the recent pancake breakfast was a success and the Protea Festival is upcoming in April.
- I. Cannabis and Social Equity Program update – Mr. Doud reported on the CPSGs' reaction to the 1/14/26 BOS meeting which approved moving the program forward with the CA State standards for setbacks, consumption lounges and events, and community benefit programs, contrary to the recommendations of the RCPG and the rest of the CPSGs in the County. Motion by Ms. Malinowski to approve the letter to

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the BOS reiterating our position and recommendations and for them to reconsider their decision, second by Ms. Dahl, approved unanimously. This letter will be shared with the CPSGs.

- J. Vallecitos School District Update – Chair Kurland. Nothing new.
- K. Fire Safety Council Update – Mr. Doud reported minor work on the website and that the next chipping event will be at the end of March.
- L. APG & SANDAG Advisory Seat for Unincorporated Communities – Ms. Malinowski has forwarded the latest email report which listed the 2026 SANDAG recap.
- M. Regional Study of Rainbow traffic concerns – Ms. Malinowski contacted the DPW Bonsall Road Station for the status on the road bed degradation on Rainbow Heights Road and was told that they planned to dig out the road in the 2 curves that were marked, stabilize the area, and repave it. Projected timeline was by the end of the summer.
- N. County Code Enforcement – Mr. Doud. Nothing new.
- O. Signs in the Rights of Way – Mr. Doud reported that the DPW does monthly drives around and are promptly removing signs.
- P. Member/Administrative Reports – Chair Kurland. Nothing new.
- Q. Road bed failure on Rainbow Heights Rd follow up – Ms. Malinowski. See Item VI.F. This item is no longer needed separately for future agendas.
- R. SDGE Pressure limiting station project recommendations follow up. Mr. Doud reported that the project has not provided any updates to the I-15 Design Review Board. Ms. Malinowski will contact the PDS project manager for status.
- S. Annual Filings and Training – Chair Kurland reminded the group to complete these requirements.
