II. Motion to approve the prior meeting minutes from May 20, 2026 by Mr. Rasp, second Ms. Eastman, approved unanimously

III. Public Comments

A. None

IV. Motion to approve of the Order of the Agenda by Ms. Malinowski, second by Ms. Eastman, approved unanimously.

V. Continued Items, Discretionary Projects and County Action Items

A. None.

VI. Old Business and Reports

A. Announcements and Correspondence Received – Chair Kurland not present.

B. Architectural Subcommittee – Ms. Malinowski reported that other CPSG chairs have reported that their community plans are 40 years old with no projected review dates, and the importance of Rainbow developing one without a certainty of being able to do so.

C. Social Media and Membership Subcommittee – Ms. Malinowski continues to post simplified messages.

D. Parks and Beautification Subcommittee – Ms. Dahl not present.

E. I-15 Corridor Design Review Board – Mr. Doud reported that there was no meeting this month because of the lack of information for the project under review.

F. Roads and traffic status – Chair Kurland not present. Ms. Malinowski reported that per the DPW, the guardrail replacement was separate from the Rainbow Heights Road damaged road-bed service request (but was unable to receive information on when that would be reviewed.) If

funding is received as expected, construction would begin in Summer 2027 with completion by Spring 2028. The Speed Limit change on Rainbow Heights Road will have signs and markings possibly by mid-July.

- G. Water and Environmental Issues Report – Chair Kurland not present.
- H. Community News and Grange – Ms. Dahl not present. Ms. Eastman reported that the bathroom remodel is in progress. A pancake brunch with craft event will be held on 7/11/26.
- I. Cannabis and Social Equity Program update – Mr. Doud reported that the BOS will vote on the program on August 19th. Ms. Malinowski reported that the SECP was discussed at the recent Quarterly Chairs meeting where the PDS Deputy Director stated that if the BOS approves the Planning Commission recommendation, parts of the ordinance would need to be ‘continued’ to allow staff to update their analysis for the changes.
- J. Vallecitos School District Update – Chair Kurland not present.
- K. Fire Safety Council Update – Mr. Doud reported that the FSC sent out their first email newsletter. The next chipping day is Saturday, 6/20/26.
- L. APG & SANDAG Advisory Seat for Unincorporated Communities – Ms. Malinowski reported on the SANDAG presentation at the in-person group meeting on 5/30/26. Funds for unincorporated areas comes from the allocation to “Local Streets and Roads” which was 18% of the total for the category.
- M. County Code Enforcement – Mr. Doud – Nothing new.
- N. Signs in the Rights of Way – Mr. Doud reported that a homebuilder put up signs north of Rainbow Vista Dr on Old Hwy 395 which continue to be put up on Fridays and taken down at the end of the weekend. The DPW is handling.
- O. Member/Administrative Reports – Chair Kurland not present. Ms. Malinowski reported on the Quarterly Chairs meeting. Tiered Winery Ordinance Expansion to Rural Residential – request presentation by Staff. Per SB 827, a new “Fiscal Training” requirement will be rolled out first to 2026 new members.
- P. SDGE Rainbow Green Streets Project follow up – Ms. Dahl not present. Group observed that it appears the majority of the work has been completed.

- A. Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT) Mitigation and related updates at 6/10/26 BOS meeting: Ms. Malinowski stated that the BOS voted to not continue with the local VMT mitigation development and to hear the analysis on best practices including what other jurisdictions are doing within 12 months from County staff.
- B. County Presentations
 - i. Housing Unlocked: Request presentation by County Staff.
 - ii. Streamlining Pathways for Housing and Agriculture: Request presentation by County Staff.
 - iii. Senior and Starter Homes: No discussion.
- C. TransNet funds Grant for Sidewalks: Mr. Doud has spoken to the SANDAG contact and a County DPW contact about preparing a grant request for sidewalks from 8th Street/Rice Canyon intersection to Rainbow Valley Blvd north to 5th Street to provide safe walking access for school children.
- D. November election candidate filing for even numbered seats: Ms. Malinowski reported that the ROV will handle candidate filing in person from 7/17/26 – 8/7/26. The CPG Chair should receive notice of the procedures by 7/15/26. Seat #10 will be available for the coming term; outreach to the community.
