7. Scenic Waiver Request, Highway 78 near Rancho Santa Teresa Rd. Owner proposes a manufactured home on a private lot with a detached garage, 3 sea cargo containers, and a storage building on APN 286-030-03-00. Only the storage building is subject to the Scenic Waiver. The storage building is 24 feet in height and 1,600 sq footage, which exceeds the 12 feet in height and 1,000 sq footage exemption requirements. Storage building to be less than 300 feet away from Highway 78. The closest property line abutting Hwy 78 is less than 50 feet away. The distance from the highway to the rear property line is less than 1,000 feet away.
