

Minutes of a teleconference meeting
of the Ramona State Routes Subcommittee held 6/24/20.

1. The meeting was brought to order at 6:30 pm.
2. A quorum was established with Robin Maxson, Maya Phillips, Dan Summers attending. Torry Brean absent..
3. Media representative Julie Gallant in attendance
4. No public commentary present.
5. Dan- Gave an update on SR 67 funding. The revised budget in light of the pandemic still includes funding for the 5 corridors and SR 67.
6. Robin- Yes, funding is in place, but none of the budgeted 21 million money has been spent yet. There are no invoices attached to the SR 67 project #.
Dan- who is currently paying Marvin Canton?
7. Robin- SANDAG will ask for a tax hike to pay for the Big Five project and the airport hub.
8. Robin- SB 743 is now in effect. A discussion ensued about the impact of SB 743 on the SR 67 project.
Dan- SB 743 supports the reduction of VMT. Adding lanes to SR 67 will not increase VMT, it will simply make those miles safer and facilitate evacuation.
Robin- In a 2019 Caltrans seminar it was stated that improving safety will not increase VMT.
Robin- Suggestion to combine mass transit with road improvement on SR 67.
9. Dan- Suggests that we put together a package for SR 67 that would include two more lanes, bicycle lanes, improved safety, facilitate evacuation, mass transit, and no increase in VMT.
- 10 Robin- Suggests a coalition of the groups involved in the 5 corridors.
11. Maya- Suggests that we approach mass transit to gain support for the SR 67 corridor.
12. Robin suggests that we have regular progress updates from Marvin Canton. A discussion resulted in an agreement that the Canton updates would occur every two months on a regular basis.
13. Dan- The RCPG is not on SANDAG's stakeholder list. Casey Lynch in handling the issue
14. Robin- On 3/11/20 Robin discussed SR 67 jurisdiction with the Sheriff and CHP. Within city limits the Sheriff has jurisdiction with the CHP as back-up. In unincorporated areas, the CHP has jurisdiction with the Sheriff as back-up.
15. Robin- Motion to adjourn at 7:33 pm. Motion seconded by Dan.
