6. APPROVAL OF ORDER OF THE AGENDA (Action)
7. ACTION ITEMS:
 - A. Discussion on road safety and traffic calming measures on the roads in the San Diego County Estates, to include enforcement, signage, speed bumps, sidewalks and other tools to make the roads safer for pedestrians and non-motorized traffic and to slow drivers down.
 - B. County staff will be presenting information on the General Plan Update for the 3 elements of Housing, Safety and Environmental Justice. The County is requesting feedback from Community Groups. The Housing Element identifies

- the unincorporated County’s housing needs and establishes goals, policies and programs. The Safety Element includes safety considerations in the planning and decision-making process by establishing policies related to future development that will minimize the risk of personal injury, loss of life, property damage, and environmental damage. The Environmental Justice Element is to incorporate environmental justice in the planning and decision-making process.
- C. County staff will be presenting information on the Final Engineering Flexibility concept. Final Engineering Flexibility is one of 14 options to streamline the discretionary review process directed by the Board of Supervisors on 2-12-20. The Final Engineering Flexibility effort proposes amendments the County Zoning Ordinance, County Subdivision Ordinance, and County Grading Ordinance to allow project changes required to comply with changes in State or Federal regulatory requirements, without requiring a modification or revised map if specific findings are made. Public comment ended 3-15-21 Discretionary Permits BPR’s may also be presented.
 - D. Cannabis and Social Equity Programs, Informational Only: Review the current ordinance, previous RCPG Chair actions and negotiated revisions to the current ordinance and a review if the 2015 Board Of Supervisors Sunset Order.
 - E. The Board of Supervisors is requesting input regarding upcoming changes to the cannabis ordinance that will include the sale of ingestible cannabis products and allow onsite consumption of cannabis products at marijuana dispensaries. Consideration is also being given to the creation of jobs in farming and manufacturing, testing and retail sales of cannabis products and the opportunity to advance social equity.
 - F. Reintroduction of emergency evacuation route through the Ramona Grasslands
 - G. County of San Diego, DPW, Annual Road Resurfacing Program Update
 - H. Discussion of an additional route, Equestrian Trail, to connect Hanson Lane to Warnock to alleviate traffic congestion in the vicinity of Hanson Lane. Consideration of again requesting the County to do a GPA so that a feasibility study can be done in the future (originally requested 8-2-18)
