4. Corrections/Approval to T&T Minutes of March 23, 2021.
Motion to approve minutes as presented made by Ken Brennecke, 2nd by Lynn Hopewell. Motion approved 6-0-0-1.

6. PRESENTATIONS FROM THE PUBLIC ON NON-AGENDA ITEMS ONLY - None
7. ACTION ITEMS:
 - a. Follow up on request to the County for a feasibility study on a road named Equestrian Trail that is to connect Dye Road with Boundary Avenue.

Consideration of again requesting the County to do a GPA so that a feasibility study can be done in the future (originally requested 8-2-18)

Casey Lynch shared that he reached Rami Talleh, and the letter that we wrote went nowhere, so nothing has been done yet. Rami is forwarding it to the advance team. Casey learned a lot about the process, when they look at the community as a whole, we're not planned to go through a General Plan in the near future. It appears that it'll be tacked onto a new General Plan list. Ken Brennecke asked if Casey knew when the new General Plan would occur? Casey said he asked that question but didn't have a date. Dawn Perfect said she thought the General Plan was done in 2020. Casey asked Rami how we get on the schedule. Rami will let Casey know that information. Robin Joy Maxson shared that the General Plan element for the safety element is being reviewed right now, with San Diego Country Estates (SDCE) roads. Is that something Casey would want to pursue with the safety element? Casey said we could try. Does Robin know when that's coming up? Casey the General Plan would be part of the mobility element. Robin shared that the General Plan Board of Supervisors are meeting in May to discuss the General Plan Update and we have an opportunity to speak as to what we want in the three of the elements, Housing, Safety and Environmental Justice. Please bring up SDCE safety calming elements. Casey thinks we did that already since we already sent the letter.

Item has been tabled.

b. Reintroduction of emergency evacuation route through the Ramona Grasslands

Casey Lynch had a conflict, so he couldn't attend the Ramona Municipal Water District meeting and asked that it be tabled. He will attend the next meeting. Dawn Perfect asked if the work on Rangeland was resolved? Casey said they had to abandon the project as they couldn't complete. Dawn asked if they cleaned up the area. Lynn Hopewell said yes.

c. County of San Diego, DPW, Annual Road Resurfacing Program Update

Casey commended Matt Rains for the work he did. Matt went by and reviewed the three roads in San Diego Country Estates, Gunn Stage from San Vicente Road to the end of Gunn Stage, Wildcat Canyon from mile post 12.0 to 1800ft west of mile post 12.0 and Vista Ramona Rd from Old Julian Highway to Sargeant Rd. Matt ultimately agreed that the others on the list weren't major repairs. Some of the roads he saw did need repair due to amount of travel. Believes the County has it right for what's on the list. Lynn Hopewell shared that she believes that D St. between 10th and 14th St. are in dire need of repair. Between 12th and 14th, the road has dips in it. But ultimately agrees with the list. Casey reviewed Montecito Way from Montecito Rd to the end and it was in pretty good condition, doesn't think it needed to be such a high priority, Olive St. from Davis St. to Summer Glen Dr. needs to be repaired there's extensive potholing and pavement falling apart. Casey agrees with the County list. Asked

if Ken Brennecke or Dawn Perfect had any input. Dawn shared that she appreciates the work the committee did as she's done the work herself.

Motion made by Dawn Perfect to move the list for approval to Ramona Community Planning Group (RCPG), 2nd by Matt Rains.
Motion approved 6-0-0-1.

8. Concerns from Members

Dawn Perfect asked about when Hwy 67 to Hwy 78 is slated for repair/resurface. Robin Joy Maxson shared that it's this Summer. CalTrans is coming to the Ramona Planning Group meeting on May 6, 2021 to discuss that timeline. They're going to take public input as to the distribution and rerouting of traffic; and the best time for the work to take place. Dawn asked so this Summer 2021, not 2022. Robin confirmed that information. Dawn said it's increasingly dangerous to travel based on how people are driving to avoid potholes. She believes it's an urgent issue. Dawn thought it was in 2022 vs. 2021, glad to hear it's this year. Robin, yes Marvin Canton is coming from the County with other County members to discuss at the May 6, 2021 Ramona Planning Group meeting.
