Frosted Faces Foundation, 1448 Pine St. Provided revision to previously RCPG approved site plan, floor plan and colored exterior elevations along with narrative of revisions for Ramona Community Planning Group's review. Proposed accessory use/building to existing Kennel operation. Building to be used as exam room and surgical suite to take care of Frosted Faces senior dogs. Proposed building will not be a veterinary clinic that is open to the public.

Andy Smisek, with Frosted Faces presented. Andy stated that since the last time plans were approved, revisions have been made to exterior of building. Originally had stone base and decorative wood siding. They changed the exterior, so it matches existing building. They're using stucco on all sides of building. There are some windows that have changed and there's a small fenced in area that will house a/c. trash cans, and. Those are the main changes. Andy reminded us that the main issue of concern is they are a scenic highway, which means they have to get approval for exterior of building. Lynn Hopewell asked if anyone had questions. Tim Corley asked if the footprint of the building/height or width changed, other than screening on side. Andy said no change to size or location, still 1600 square foot building, in same spot. Robin Joy Maxson said so it's going to more closely resemble the main building on the property. Will construction be less due to change of materials. Andy said yes that's the other incentive to change as it'll be cheaper to go with all stucco vs. decorative wood and siding. Will save money to use for non-profit needs. Tim asked if the exiting building is it the same color, La Habra stucco, will it match other building as much as possible. Andy want to clarify that Tim was asking name of color. Tim said yes, it says colors. Do the colors represent existing building. Andy said yes, they are as close to color pallet that they had to choose from.

Lynn made Andy aware that he needs to come to the Ramona Design Review Board meeting being held on October 27, 2022.

Motion made by Tim Corley to approve changes as submitted, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Maya Phillips. Motion carried 4-0-0-1 (Kevin Wallace absent).
