

- a. Q&A Session with Ernie Bartley from the county about median closure at San Vicente Rd and Arena Dr, and potential plan B discussion based on previous community feedback
 - i. Murali Presented Solution, explaining it as a whole and breaking it down is not appropriate because there is a method to the madness with all the stop signs, including the median closure. He highlighted that the reason this intersection was SO important was because of the sure volume per hour of cars at that intersection. He also mentioned we cannot simply do nothing with the intersection and that some controls would be required and that we can't leave it the way it is.
 - ii. Most everyone agreed with not taking action on this intersection.

- iii. Joe Cahak Brought up multiple issues from emergency vehicles, to crossing multiple intersections and other intersections including the shopping center traffic to get home.
- iv. The exchange between Joe and Murali went on for some time without complete consensus on the table.
- v. Robin asked if the type of vehicles was recorded during the sampling, since the increase of delivery vehicles and wondered if this was one possibility.
- vi. Murali did acknowledge that they do not have a way to count the vehicles, however most happened in the PM timeframe which is why they thought it was not the case.
- vii. Ken mentioned, Murali had earlier mentioned 4 way controls.
- viii. Peggy asked if we are back to square one?
- ix. Matt Explained that it's not square one, because if we would have agreed with the proposal then we would be moving to the next steps.
- x. Murali Explained that there are also liability issues and that the changes must be engineered to stand up in court, and the engineering team needs to be able to confidently back get behind the changes suggested.
- xi. Murali Will ultimately go back and come up with other options, for the short mid and long term.
