The "San Diego County Unincorporated Communities" Advisory Board Member and their Alternate would be selected from among one of the 28 elected Community Planning Groups and/or appointed Community Sponsor Groups Chairs. These 28 Community Planning and Sponsor Group Chairs would select a representative and alternate every 2 years.
