

Ramona Community Planning Group: Transportation & Trails Minutes

June 24, 2025, 7 pm

1. Call to order & Pledge of Allegiance: 7 02 pm
2. Determination of Members present & quorum: Present: Joe Cajak, Cheryl Wenger, Rachelle Laws, Dawn Perfect. Absent: Paul Tarr, Basil Aruin
3. **Approval of previous meeting minutes (April 29, 2024) Rachelle/Cheryl. Unan.**
4. Public comment on items not on the agenda (3 minutes max per speaker) **None**
5. Elm Street at Poplar St: Safety concerns from residents. Traffic study done Feb 2014 & previous RCPG actions Feb 2018.

Community member, Beverly Torres, addressed the group regarding safety concerns on Elm Street at the intersection of Poplar Street. She shared her knowledge of accidents and suggestions for improvement. The same information had been shared with the subcommittee & RCPG in the past, but concerns still exist.

RCPG Minutes from Feb 2018 were reviewed, which cite a 2014 study and resulting actions. There was discussion about reporting vegetation management along the roadside to the county “Get it Done” system to improve visibility, warning signs that were installed, but maybe not in the optimal locations and mailboxes that are in an unsafe location (still). Ramona Municipal Water District is planning changes to the park on the Elm St side, so consensus of the group was that a county traffic study would be best done after those changes.

Motion: RCPG to again contact the postmaster regarding unsafe mailbox placement and recommend moving mailboxes off Elm Street to Poplar, referring to the RCPG action in 2018 and ongoing safety concerns. Cheryl/Joe. Unan.

County Capital Improvement List (CIP): Dawn explained difficulty reaching any representative at the county, and reviewed the Ramona specific items on the overall county CIP list but was not able to obtain updates at the time of the meeting.
