7. TPM 21212 RPL Minor subdivision corner of Hanson Lane and Ashley Road.
Mr. Joe Zenovic clarified the parcel map identifying changes, set backs on Ashley Rd. and Hanson Lane. Discussion of road width and the expected curb, gutter, sidewalk. The corner parcel is privately owned and has built up to the property line. The subdivision's parcels off Hanson will have an access road, with driveways coming off of that instead of directly off of Hanson. Discussion of corner property matching curb, gutter, sidewalk from this project. It appears there's a 10' pathway on Hanson and on Ashley as well.
