- 4. OPEN FORUM None
- 5. GENERAL PLANNING ITEMS:
 - A. **Update to Lake Hodges Deteriorating Condition.** State orders to lower water levels for reservoirs with poorly maintained dams have created an environmental crisis at Lake Hodges. Lake Hodges birds have had to relocate their rookeries elsewhere, and a fish die-off has occurred. As the water levels drop, the lake's stench increases as the surrounding organic debris decomposes and cannot circulate and break down properly. **Presenters** John Anshus and Paul Bernstein discussed raising the lake to 293 feet from its current 280 feet above sea level to reduce 500 acres of flammable brush and support 26 endangered species. Requesting DOSC to consider downstream and upstream impacts by increasing the lake to 293 feet due to upstream consequences, with low downstream impacts of an earthquake event of flooding, increased risks of Fire both downstream and upstream, continued impacts to endangered species, and restoration of Cielo Pump Station for local water supply.

Motion: (D.Dill) To write a letter supporting the raising of the Lake Hodges dam to 293 feet to Chairman Nick Serano. San Diego Water Authority.
