1. STP-14-012-W1- 9464 San Diego St. corner of Grand – Adult Day Care – Proponent – Joe Martinez, Presenter – Robles

2. STP -17-025 Proposed Duplex 1056 Leland St. Proponent - Enrique Ocampo, Presenter - Lowes

The project follows the Design Review Guidelines and there will be no signage on the buildings. There will be a two car garage for each unit, one guest parking and no ADA parking. Each unit will have a private open space. Additionally, there will be a tot lot towards the back of the property and the material surface is going to be grass. Proponent committed to moving trash dumpster so it will face east in order to alleviate the concern of safety for the tot lot. Also, the guest parking will be moved south next to the dumpster. There is a desire for more landscape and concerns about parking and the fire lane.

Robles motioned to approve the plans with the conditions of moving the dumpster 90 degrees with doors opening to the east and shift the guest parking down next to the dumpster. Additionally, County should verify all setbacks, that proponent specify fencing Tot lot for County to consider allowing landscaping adjacent to bio filter. Flores seconded.
