1. **San Diego County Public Work Project; San Carlos St Sewer Main Replacement Project.** replacement of existing sewer on San Carlos St – from Grand Ave to Ramona Ave. Construction anticipated to start April 2019 lasting 2 months. Presenter: Custeau; Proponent: Ryan Lau – Public Works; Our planning group will consider voting to recommend approval of this project. Additionally, Mr. Lau will present for information only, Sweetwater Springs Blvd Storm Drain Restoration Project – replace leaking storm drains from 50’ north of Loma Lane to 300’ south of Loma Lane. Start date expected within two months, with 2 months for construction.
2. **Letter to Caltrans regarding the status of the SR-94/SR-125 Interchange Project;** Presenter: Pearson; Group member Pearson drafted a letter to Caltrans asking about the status of this project. The group will consider directing the Chair to send this letter to all interested parties as indicated in the letter.
3. **2018-19 PLDO Priority List;** Presenter: Lowes; the group will identify projects and their priority for the use of PLDO money for this coming year.
4. **B Designator Site Plan Waiver for signage at the Higher Learning Academy, 9467 Jamacha Blvd.** Presenter: Lowes, Proponent: Marco Lipp. The applicant is proposing to add two wall signs totaling 69.83 sq. ft. The group will review the proposal and consider a vote to approve.
