

Final Minutes: September 20, 2017 meeting of the
TWIN OAKS VALLEY COMMUNITY SPONSOR GROUP

A. Roll Call and Advisory Role Statement

Tom Kumura called the meeting to order at 7:05pm. Present: Karen Binns (Co-Vice Chair), Rob Peterson and Ana Rosvall. Absent: Colleen Branin, Sandra Farrell and Erik Chapman. Tom Kumura read the Advisory Role Statement and Public Forum statements.

B. Review/Approval of Minutes: August 2017 Meeting minutes were not ready and will be presented at the October Meeting.

C. Public Communications: Community members spoke on various topics.

D. Action Item: Climate Action Plan (CAP) Public Review, PDS2015-POD-15-002, PDS2016-GPA-16-007, LOG NO. PDS2016-ER-16-00-003. The project includes strategies and measures to reduce GHG emissions from the unincorporated county and County operations. The CAP proposes 11 GHG Reduction Strategies and 29 GHG Reduction Measures that the County would implement to reduce GHG emissions. Letter was edited to include several key comments made and motion was made by Ana Rosvall and seconded by Karen Binns to send the letter to the County.

Vote was 4-0-0 for approval of letter.

2. Update regarding Landscaping and other issues near the Quintessa Project. Lindsay Townley presented photographs of the Quintessa embankments taken today. The few Sycamore trees that were planted looked stressed as did the other plants in the photograph. Members of the Sponsor Group noted the poor quality of the plants in the picture. Lindsay is going to set up a meeting with the SD County representatives and bring the results of the meeting back to the TOVCSG. No other discussion or action was taken.

3. Review latest status of 1) the TOVCSG Community Plan, 2) changes to Buena Creek Road, 3) Adjustment to Boundary of the TOVCSG, 4) Status of North County MCSP.

SD County Representatives have not provided written response. This will be placed on the Agenda for October as a Discussion /Action Item.
