Resource Protection Ordinance and the Grading Ordinance: At the direction of the County Board of Supervisors, as a way to increase housing affordability, the County of San Diego Planning & Development Services is considering changes to the RPO and the Grading Ordinance in order to reduce costs, add clarity, and streamline the development process.
