

Final Minutes: March, 16th, 2016 meeting of the
TWIN OAKS VALLEY COMMUNITY SPONSOR GROUP

Roll Call and Advisory Role Statement

Kumura called the meeting to order. Present: Tom Kumura (Chair), Karen Binns (Co-Vice Chair), Sandra Farrell, Rob Peterson, Erik Chapman (Co-Vice Chair), and Colleen Branin.

Tom Kumura read the Advisory Role Statement and Public Forum statement.

Review/Approval of Minutes: Approval of February, 17th 2016 Meeting Minutes (6-0-0)

Public Communications:

A community member that lives on Buena Creek Rd spoke on the dangers of the road. He has had accidents in front of his home on several occasions and complained to the County over the years. He requested that road safety on Buena Creek be addressed next month.

A community member wrote up a summary on the Commissioners meeting last week. She read her summary to the public and provided copies of a NC Times newspaper article about North County development.

A community member addressed the development of Newland Sierra and stated her opinion that access to the development should be at a new interchange on I-15 and not Deer Springs. Additional traffic from Newland Sierra on Deer Springs will lead to additional traffic on Twin Oaks and Buena Creek.

Action Items:

1. Park Lands Dedication Ordinance (PLDO): Mr. Marcus Lubich, Park Project Manager, San Diego County Parks and Recreation. Marcus.Lubich@sdcounty.ca.gov; (858)-966-1348. Mr. Lubich provided an overview of active, passive and linear parks. Community members asked questions on using land for parks and trails for hiking, cycling, equestrian, and non-motorized vehicles. It was discussed about using linear parks or hybrid parks in the North Twin Oaks area. **Action Item-** A motion was made to make a sub-committee to write a letter to change the definition from passive to active park to allow use by hiking, cycling, equestrian, and non-motorized vehicles. Passed 6-0-0

Discussion involved the trash problems at the sprinter stations and bus stops, specifically Buena Creek Sprinter Station.
