1. **The Meeting started at 6:34 P.M.**
2. **Establish Quorum**
  - a. **Present**

3. **Pledge of Allegiance**
  - a. **Guest Kevin Smith asked to lead the pledge**
4. **Public Communication/Open Forum** – any subject not on the agenda (max. 3 minutes).
5. **Review and Approval of Minutes from subcommittee meetings.**
  - a. Minutes for November, February and March distributed at the meeting. Jon Vick wished to review the minutes. Claire Plotner decided to approve these minutes at the next meeting.
6. **Discussion and Possible Motion** on adding modern roundabouts at VC Road and the Mirar de Valle and Miller intersections to VC's DPW Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) list as Priority #1, and requiring the developers of the N. Village to install roundabouts instead of 2 additional traffic lights between Cole Grade and Miller Roads (4 traffic lights within 1 mile), subject to the VC Fire District's approval of the design (Plotner, Vick)

**Jon Vick** stated that the Valley View casino expansion and Lilac Hills Ranch traffic impacts create a level of service of F on Valley Center Road and the county plans to accept that level of service on Valley Center Road.

**Larry Glavinic** stated that he doesn't like placement of roundabout on Miller Road as he states that there are no alternatives to S6.

**Dorothy Ken** has safety concerns about roundabouts such as DUI driving the wrong way, failure to yield. States that CHP data is needed.

**Will Rogers** states that roundabouts are great but not in peak traffic.

**Claire Plotner** stated that flow through traffic might take Woods Valley Road or Highway 76.

**Motion tabled by Jon Vick.**
7. **Discussion and Possible Vote** on walkthrough of oaks with the county, an arborist, VCCPG Mobility Subcommittee, neighbors and on Cole Grade Road with a focus on Cool Valley Road. (Plotner)

**Claire Plotner** stated that this would be considered a public meeting and would infringe on the privacy of the land holders. As such, the activity was cancelled. It was suggested that the project manager, Ryan Lau could be contacted for a walk through with Susan Moore.

Arellano, P.E.**, Project Manager, DPW, CIP, on clarification of how the county assesses road priorities on its' Capital Improvement Program list. How does the county consider planning group road priorities of new roads, improvement of current roads, and pathways, safety issues, etc.? Possible discussion of a realignment of priorities for roads and pathways.
