**5. Discussion and Possible Vote on CIP Revision**

Changes to CIP list to include moving the Vesper Road Type D Special Pathway to the CIP Priority 3. In addition, discussion on removing the new roads from the CIP list as the county does not put in new roads. Concern that pressure should be put on the county for new roads in our developing community may be important to the roads eventual construction. (Plotner)

Jon Vick propose the following:

#1: Roundabout at Mirar de Valle and VC Roads

#2: Roundabout at Miller and VC Roads

#3: Trail along Vesper Road from Cole Grade Road to Mac Tan Road

#4: Add landscaped median in S. Village

#5: Resurface and add bike lanes to VC Road from Cole Grade Road to Rincon

#6: Extend Heritage Trail east along VC Road to Lake Wolhford Road.

#7: Extend Mirar de Valle west to connect with Escondido roads

#8: New Road 19

#9: New Road 14

#10: Replace all traffic signals on VC Road with roundabouts to calm traffic and to reduce injury and fatality accidents.

**6. Discussion and Possible Vote on Evaluating the Valley Center Community Evacuation Road Study (CERS)**

Motion; "That the Mobility Subcommittee evaluate the CERS list of work and prioritize those roads for completion separately from the Mobility CIP list as previously submitted. (Kennedy)

**7. Presentation on Alternatives to Surface Road Modes of Transportation and Corridors**

A forward-thinking approach to current transportation methods may include air corridors for drones, emergency supplies. In addition, tunnels may provide an alternative to standard roads. (Glavinic)

**8. Discussion of Invitation extended to Everett Hauser, AICP, PTP, Transportation Specialist, Planning and Development Services**

Everett Hauser will be making a presentation at the July 9<sup>th</sup> Monday meeting of the Valley Center Community Planning Group. The Mobility Subcommittee will address several issues that have been brought up as concerns of the community and present a document that will be a list of some of the issues of the community.
