As you may already be aware, San Marcos is a "Pass Through" city. By that I mean that thousands of commuters pass through San Marcos to and from work each day. This makes it difficult for residents to get around. In addition two colleges full of driving students make the situation even worse.

I-281-1

Rt 78, San Marcos Blvd, Rancho Santa Fe Rd and mostly Twin Oaks Valley Rd. get backed up everyday. It can take a half hour or more to get through San Marcos with all the traffic and stop lights. Twin Oaks has to be avoided after 3 PM because the traffic backs up on Deer Springs heading to the 15. It usually backs up to La Cienega.

Too often N/B I-15 traffic backs up into Escondido which completely ties up the Deer Springs I-15 overpass.

Add to this we've been told for years there's not enough water and we don't see any dams being built. There's not enough electricity yet the nuclear power plants were shut down.

You need to consider what a disaster it would be to build 2100 new homes (with 4200 cars.) And have them access Twin Oaks Valley - Deer Springs Rd.
