I am writing to express concern regarding the proposed Newland Sierra Project. If completed, the project would destroy the beauty and quiet of an area that has become a spiritual refuge for my religious community.

For the past 15 years, two different Buddhist meditation communities to which I belong, Vista Zen Center and Three Treasures Zen Community have been holding retreats at the Hidden Valley Zen Center on Sarver Road in San Marcos. I understand that the Newland Sierra Project would bring an enormous volume of traffic that cannot be accommodated by present roads or freeways, require a water supply that goes far beyond what is available, violate the General Plan which allows for 99 housing units only, and in general destroy the semi-rural character of the area. This must not happen.
