I am writing to register my strong objection to the Newland Sierra Project. As a resident of the Hidden Meadows Community I want to register a list of reasons for my objections:	I-327-1
1. I am concerned about building in a very high risk fire zone. As a large animal owner I only have two ways out Hidden Meadows, one through Rim Rock the other through Hidden Meadows Road (you cannot get a trailer through Cougar Pass). This is already a bottle neck onto the I15. Add another 2,000 dwellings and lets be conservative and say 2,000 cars all trying to get onto the I15 at the same exit and you have a disaster on your hands.
