Daily use traffic trips – 25,000 in/out on Deer Springs road. ĪI-389-3 II-389-4 II-389-5 II-389-6 . Brings Interstate 15, the Deer Springs interchange and Deer Springs Rd. to a level of failing. · A rock crushing operation generating dust, noise and vibration for the 3-6 yrs of building. • No evacuation during emergencies due to traffic congestion. The surrounding rural area is not ready to handle the influx of that many new people to the area. The necessary road, 1-389-7 infrastructure and fire safety improvements are not in place and there does not seem to be a plan to put them in place. In the past, this has been denied by the County Supervisors. Also, there has since been an \$18 million study done on the area with taxpayer money. The recent study addresses many of these concerns. As you know, the area is currently zoned for I-389-8 99 houses...the 2135 anticipated units is greater than 210% more than this. I am not necessarily opposed to growth and development, but I am opposed to development that is grossly out of step with the general plan for this area. II-389-9 How can a plan of this magnitude that is so far outside of the scope of the general plan even be considered?

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
