- I-204-1 The comment states that the project would not only endanger their way of life but in the event of a fire, it would utterly ruin their ability to evacuate. An Evacuation Plan was prepared and included in the Draft EIR as Appendix N-2. - I-204-2 The comment states that traffic is already horrific and adding 2,135 homes would make it dangerous and ruin property values. Potential traffic impacts were extensively analyzed in the Draft EIR at Section 2.13 Transportation and Traffic.
