

I-250 Rebecca Lindsay

- I-250-1** The commenter explains that they have reviewed the Draft EIR and believe that the existing transportation infrastructure is inadequate to address the current population, let alone the Project. The comment states that the main roads in the area are riddled with potholes and grass, and the County should focus on existing infrastructure rather than accommodating higher density development.

Traffic impacts and proposed improvements are disclosed in Section 2.13 Traffic and Transportation. There are a number of roadway, interchange, and signal improvements that are included as part of the proposed project. The comment does not raise any specific issue regarding that analysis and, therefore, no more specific response can be provided or is required. The County will include the comment as part of the Final EIR for review and consideration by the decision-makers prior to a final decision on the project.

- I-250-2** The commenter explains that in 20 years of living in San Diego uncontrolled growth has led to the deterioration to the quality of life, especially with regards to traffic and aesthetics. The commenter explains that she recognizes that a property owner has a right to develop their land, but developers should familiarize themselves with the General Plan.
