- I-424-1** The commenter explains that her and her husband purchased their home in Vista in 1973. The commenter describes the area when they first moved there and explains that it was less populated and developed; therefore, there was less noise, traffic, and light pollution.

- I-424-4** The comment states that the road now experiences heavy traffic from 6 AM to 8 PM, but steady traffic begins around 4:30 AM to 5 AM and goes until 7:30 PM to 8 PM.

- I-424-5** The comment states that the exponential increase in traffic would prevent people from evacuating during a wildfire. The commenter explains that they are opposed to the Project.
