To Whom It May Concern:

The Grossmont Union High School District (GUHSD) appreciates the opportunity to provide comments on the subject Draft EIR (DEIR). GUHSD provides public education for grades 9-12 plus adult education in East San Diego County and has a high interest in this proposed project.

We have several comments in Section 3.1.6 Public Services.

- 1. On page 3.1.6-5, under "Grossmont Union High School District", Steele Canyon High School is identified as the nearest high school to the Project Area. Steele Canyon High School is a charter school sponsored by GUHSD, and as a charter school, does not have defined boundaries which determine enrollment eligibility for resident students. The GUHSD school that serves the territory in which the proposed project is planned is Valhalla High School. Please revise the DEIR accordingly.
- 2. On page 3.1.6.29, under "High Schools", the first sentence says SUHSD would serve high school students from Village 14. A portion of Village 14 resides in the territory served by GUHSD. In order for these residents to be served by SUHSD, a transfer of territory would have to be approved through a process. GUHSD strongly objects to such a transfer.
- 3. Regarding page 3.1.6-30, "Grossmont Unified High School District", the proper name is Grossmont <u>Union</u> High School District. Also, this section repeats the identification of Steele Canyon High School as serving students from Planning Areas 16/19. As explained in Comment (1) above, the GUHSD school that serves the territory in which the Planning Areas 16/19 is Valhalla High School. Please revise the DEIR accordingly.
