The following are my comments on the Village 14 DEIR. Note-please respond via email, not via snail mail.

I-20-1

Village 14 will disrupt swaths of exceedingly rare large areas of wildlife habitat. It would also extirpate 1-2 nesting areas and disrupt almost 1300 acres of habitat for Golden Eagles. According to Golden Eagle biologists, approximately 10 Golden Eagles have used this area for foraging continually since the 2007 fires. Please remove the impacts from the Golden Eagle habitat and nesting areas.

The Proctor Valley as a whole is an ecologically important areas and is close to other protected open space areas, which creates badly needed wildlife connectivity. The DEIR does not adequately protect the MSCP. Please remove the impacts from the MSCP.
