**I13-1** The comment questions whether the CAP included measures related to increased waste diversion, specifically organics. The CAP includes GHG Reduction Measure SW 1.1 (see page 3-62 of the Draft CAP) which would commit the County to a solid waste diversion rate of 75% by 2030. The County acknowledges support for the CAP. The comment will be included in the Final EIR and made available to the decision makers prior to a final decision on the project.
