Traffic roundabouts significantly decrease fuel consumption and emissions and should be added as a Climate Action Plan strategy to reduce GHG emissions.

According to the San Diego Air Pollution Control District (APCD) document on Modern Roundabouts, each roundabout can eliminate 189 metric tons of CO2 emissions annually. As noted in the APCD document, in addition to significant CO2 emissions and improved air quality, roundabouts provide other significant multi-modal benefits including increased safety for vehicles and pedestrians, and improved traffic flow.

Thank you for adding traffic roundabouts to the CAP GHG emission reduction strategies.

In addition, I believe it's important that whatever goes into the CAP update must be consistent with and supportive of the County's updated General Plan. The CAP should help
