While I support some aspects of the draft Climate Action Plan, I ask that the County add a strong component to reduce the vehicle miles traveled – and thus greenhouse gas emissions – generated from newly planned residential development. The plan should not facilitate far-flung sprawl that undermines the region's efforts to become a carbon-efficient economy.

*It is incumbent upon the County to use its land use authority to put in place **sustainable patterns of development near jobs** and transit, as called for by the State of California. Mass transit plans and incentives are sorely needed, as well. Please consider a more progressive and forward-looking plan that will protect ourselves and our future generations.*
