Thank you for providing Sweetwater Authority with a copy of the Notice of Availability of a Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Report and General Plan Amendment for the San Diego County Climate Action Plan (CAP). We understand that the purpose of the CAP is to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions from community and County operations.

While conducting our review, we noted that one of the proposed goals to reduce GHG emissions is the implementation of the East County Multiple Species Conservation Program (ECMSCP) (Measure No. T-1.1). Sweetwater Authority owns and manages the Loveland Reservoir property, which is located in the Sweetwater River watershed and within the boundaries of the proposed ECMSCP in the Alpine Community Planning Area. If the County proceeds with the conceptual development of the ECMSCP, Sweetwater Authority would appreciate being invited to participate in the process as a stakeholder.
