RE: Notice of Availability (NOA) of a Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) for the Campo Wind Project with Boulder Brush Facilities (Project)

Dear Ms. Harris:

San Diego Gas and Electric Company (SDG&E) respectfully submits this letter in response to the NOA for the above-referenced Project. SDG&E is a utility regulated by the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) that provides electric and gas services to customers throughout San Diego County. The CPUC mandates that SDG&E maintain its utility infrastructure.

SDG&E is providing the following comments on the DEIR:

- As stated in the DEIR, SDG&E will be constructing the connection of the switchyard to the Sunrise Powerlink, and the switchyard will be transferred to SDG&E after construction. Both the connection to the switchyard and the switchyard itself are subject to CPUC jurisdiction and would not be subject to County jurisdiction or to the requirements of the Major Use Permit issued by the County for their operation and maintenance.
- As required by the California Environmental Quality Act, SDG&E considers that the DEIR addresses all potential impacts to environmental resources, both temporary and permanent, and is sufficient to secure all required mitigation related to the Project, including but not limited to the Project components either constructed or ultimately owned by SDG&E.
- Landscaping, revegetation and/or habitat enhancement plans for the Project shall not inhibit SDG&E's access to its facilities for purposes including, but not limited to, construction, upgrading, repair, operation or maintenance. All Project mitigation measures must be placed outside of the right of way, access roads, and maintenance pads.
- Page 1-5: Please change "control house" to read "control shelter".
- Page 1-7: Please add the following text; "SDG&E will have use of the access roads after construction is complete for the purpose of operations and maintenance of their facilities."
- Page 2.5-8: Hazardous Materials Disposal section, the last sentence states the following; "Within unincorporated San Diego County, multiple treatment, storage, and disposal facility sites exist, such as those owned and operated by the U.S. military and SDG&E."
