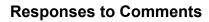
I14 Charles Good

- The County of San Diego acknowledges the comment and notes that it expresses opposition to the Campo Wind Project with Boulder Brush Facilities (Project) but does not raise any issue concerning the adequacy of the Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR). No further response is required.
- The comment states that the turbines create a visual eyesore at 586 feet tall. In response, the visual impacts of the Project, including the proposed wind turbines, are analyzed in Chapter 2.1, Aesthetics, of the Draft EIR. It was determined that the Project would result in significant and unavoidable impacts pertaining to changes in visual character and/or quality, community character, scenic vistas, and light and glare. The comment does not provide any information that would necessitate revisions to the aesthetic impact analysis contained within the Draft EIR.
- The comment states that the turbines are a noise polluter. Noise impacts are discussed in Chapter 2.6, Noise, and the Appendix G, Acoustical Analysis Report, of the Draft EIR. The Draft EIR determined noise generated by operation of the turbines would result in significant and unavoidable impacts. Please also refer to Global Response GR-4, Noise. The comment does not provide any specific information relating to the adequacy of the analysis contained within the Draft EIR.
- The comment states that property values will be decimated and suggests that San Diego Gas & Electric should fairly compensate the property owners. This comment does not raise an issue regarding the adequacy of the analysis within the Draft EIR. In regard to property values, please refer to Global Response GR-1, Socioeconomic Impacts.
