- I23-1** The comment provides an introduction to the letter, with general concern regarding the Campo Wind Project with Boulder Brush Facilities (Project). The comment does not raise an issue related to the adequacy of the analysis contained within the Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR); therefore, no further response is required.
- I23-2** The comment expresses concern regarding health issues from previously approved projects. The comment also states that there are limited water resources. Please refer to Global Response GR-2, Public Health. In regard to water resources, Draft EIR Chapter 3.1.5, Hydrology and Water Quality, fully addresses potential impacts related to groundwater and water quality. Also please refer to the Groundwater Resources Evaluation (Appendix J-1) and the Groundwater Reports for Boundary Creek and Flat Creek Watersheds (Appendices J-2 and J-3, respectively) of the Draft EIR. The comment does not raise an issue regarding the adequacy of the analysis within the Draft EIR; therefore, no further response is required.
- I23-3** The comment states the author has experienced blades shattering and fires from exploding generators. The comment also states they have been lucky so far with the dangers these generators create to humans, the environment, and wildlife. Please refer to Global Response GR-7 and EIR Chapters 2.5 Hazards and Hazardous Materials and 2.9 Wildfire for detailed discussions regarding wildfire risk specific to the Project. The comment does not raise an issue regarding the adequacy of the analysis provided in the Draft EIR; therefore, no further response is required.
- I23-4** The comment states they are part of a rural community and these projects, if allowed, will diminish property value. The comment concludes with a statement of opposition to the Project. In regard to property values, please refer to Global Response GR-1, Socioeconomic Impacts. The comment does not raise an issue regarding the adequacy of the analysis provided in the Draft EIR; therefore, no further response is required.
