

- The County of San Diego acknowledges the comment and notes that it expresses opposition to the Campo Wind Project with Boulder Brush Facilities (Project). The comment does not raise any issue concerning the adequacy of the analysis in the Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR); therefore, no further response is required.
- The comment states that the behemoth wind turbines are even worse than static skyscrapers, and the motion of the blades and blinking lights cannot be ignored night or day. The comment further states that the turbines destroy the reason local residents chose to reside in the area. Chapter 2.1, Aesthetics, of the Draft EIR analyzes the potential effects to visual resources as a result of the Project. Please also refer to Global Response GR-8, Visual Impacts. The comment does not raise an issue related to the adequacy of the analysis contained within the Draft EIR; therefore, no further response is required.
- The comment expresses concern regarding the Project devaluing residents' homes and having a negative psychological role on their daily lives. - The comment asks what retribution to the harmed local land and homeowners is planned. The comment also refers to future legal actions that may follow, and states that these projects are designed for financial profits without meaningful consideration of local residents that feel all the negative attributes of the projects.
