There is a solar power project # PDS2018-MUP-18-022. I was writing to inform you that as acting chairman of the Jacumba community services that I have heard little, or nothing about this project. I recently found out that there was a "public review period" that just closed on December 7th 2020.

I would like to voice the concerns of myself, and the community, and in particular a concern about the "Horned lizard" populations, that reside within the area. The lizard is currently on the endangered species list, and without a proper review of the project, the project may be endangering the lizard further, and may be in danger of disappearing from the area altogether. Without the proper research on the impact that this new project may have we may not know until it's too late.

On behalf of myself, the other board members, and the Jacumba hot springs community would like to have this reviewed. With the proper resources from the U.S Fish and wildlife services, the impact assessment can be implemented. Until then we ask that the project be put on hold.
