Please find PDS-543, with its accompanying comments letter dated May 31, 2021 which address the Jacumba Community Sponsor Group's reasons for denying the revised 623-acre JVR project. Also attached are the draft minutes from our last sponsor group meeting held on May 18, 2021. The comments letter and meeting minutes identify some different issues regarding project plot plans dated 04/08/2021 and they merit a thorough review.

The sponsor group hopes PDS will require the developer to incorporate additional BMPs into a smaller project footprint (250 to 300 acres), one that is pulled further away from residences, scenic highways and the Jacumba Airport. We believe this is a reasonable compromise, one that will allow the developer to meet the goal of producing up to 90MW of power and one that will not destroy Jacumba.
