Dear Supervisor Lawsom-Remer,

I have been following your work since you were sworn in at the beginning of this year, and have been so impressed by the actions you and your office have taken towards SMART justice, immigration reform, and protecting San Diego's native land and wildlife, not to mention the efforts you have put in to keep San Diego residents safe throughout the pandemic. I believe many of your constituents and colleagues look up to for all those reasons and more.

I am urging you to use your positive influence to prevent the great inequity that is the proposed JVR Energy Park project. If approved, the construction and operation of this solar farm would be devastating to the surrounding rural, low-income community which San Diego has an obligation to protect.
