The project proposes a Major Use Permit and Tentative Parcel Map to subdivide the 19-acre property into two legal lots for a Hobby Farm retail store (Tractor Supply Co.) and a self-storage facility. The property is located at 3018 Jefferson Road in the Jamul community of the Mountain Empire Subregional Plan area, within unincorporated San Diego County. The site is subject to the Semi-Rural Regional Category and the Rural Commercial (C-4) Land Use Designation. The Zoning Use Regulation for the site is General Commercial (C-36) with a "P" Special Area Designator. The project is consistent with the requirements of the General Plan and Zoning Ordinance.

Access would be provided by two private driveways connecting each parcel to Jefferson Road, a County maintained road. Water service would be provided by the Otay Water District and individual onsite wastewater systems (supplemental treatment systems) are proposed. Proposed earthwork quantities for the project consist of 20,000 cubic yards of cut and 65,000 cubic yards of fill with no export required.
