"PDS has been asked to respond regarding the potential effect of the Zoning Ordinance Amendment approved on October 29, 2014 on the proposed North County

Environmental Resources Recycling (NCER) Facility proposed in the Twin Oaks Sponsor Group Area. This property would not be affected by the new Zoning Ordinance Update to Section 6158.e. The amendment to the Accessory Use Regulations only applies to persons having an approved Major Use Permit for a mining and processing land use, or having an established mining and processing land use that is legally nonconforming as of October 29, 2014. The NCER property is not an existing mining site; rather, the site is considered a stand-alone Recycling Processing Facility and therefore not subject to the proposed changes to allow recycling in conjunction with existing, legally established mining sites.
